Academic and Administrative Activities, 2022 Spring Semester

To Albizu Community:


Greetings. I hope that each one of you is in good health and enjoying a well-deserved holiday break. During the past weeks there has been a dramatic increase in the number of Covid-19 infections, caused mainly by the spread of a new variant. Given this scenario, Albizu University will start the Spring Semester in the following manner:

1. Academic activities at the San Juan Campus, the Miami Campus and the Mayagüez University Center will be conducted in a remote modality until Friday, January 28, 2022. To the extent that infections are reduced, and the situation normalizes, we will be reviewing this modality.
2. The laboratories, clinical practices and student services will be available in person, observing social distancing, the use of mask and other safety and hygiene measures necessary to control exposure against Covid-19.
3. Administrative work in all our units will be conducted onsite during regular hours, observing social distancing, use of mask and other safety and hygiene measures necessary to control exposure against Covid-19.
4. The Albizu Clinics in all their locations will continue to offer services in a hybrid format, combining telehealth and face to face, as appropriate.

As we have done in the past, we take these safeguards to protect the safety and well-being of all our community members. We urge you to continue implementing health prevention strategies at the individual and family level to reduce the risks of exposure, particularly during this holiday period.

As these plans change, we will communicate them promptly. For now, I want to wish you a happy New Year.
